

## J. MCCLELLAND CELLARS CABERNET SAUVIGNON

VINTAGE: 2017

APPELLATION: NAPA VALLEY

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 92.5% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 5% MERLOT, 2.5% CABERNET FRANC

## WINEMAKING:

All fruit was harvested prior to the fires in early October. The grapes were de-stemmed, fermented and aged separately in six different lots. All aging was in French oak barrels for 30 months.

## WINE NOTES:

AROMAS OF BLACK CHERRY, CURRANT, RHUBARB AND A TOUCH OF RED ROSE FLOW INTO THE MOUTH WITH SIMILAR FLAVORS COMPLEXED BY BLACK PEPPER AND BRIARY, RIPE TANNINS. PRECISELY BALANCED WITH A POLISHED TEXTURE AND A LONG FINISH; IT IS READY TO ENJOY UPON RELEASE BUT STILL YOUNG WITH VERY LONG AGING POTENTIAL. 959 CASES PRODUCED
